I. STATUS

A. Meetings:

- The Herring Plan Development Team (PDT) discussed the development of Framework 4 on a January 6, 2014 conference call and is expected to meet during February and March to work on the development of the Framework 4 document and related analyses.
- The Herring Committee met on January 14, 2014, and the Herring Advisory Panel (AP) met on January 22, 2014 to begin the development of options for consideration in Framework 4 to the Atlantic Herring FMP. Framework 4 may address some of the disapproved elements of Amendment 5, including dealer weighing provisions and measures to address net slippage. The Committee and AP also reviewed/discussed the development of the omnibus amendment to establish provisions for industry-funded monitoring and observer coverage targets for the herring and mackerel fisheries (see Tab 14 for information related to the Omnibus Industry-Funded Monitoring Amendment).
