## SMALL MESH MULTISPECIES ADVISORY PANEL STATEMENT TO COUNCIL

With regard to the four items scoped for the upcoming small mesh multispecies management action, the Advisory Panel recommends to the Council the following:

- 1. For Limited Entry qualification criteria:
  - a. That the control date of March 25, 2003 be utilized.
  - b. That, at a minimum, documented landings inception dates of in-or-around 1981 and in-or-around 1993 and/or 1995 should be included.
  - c. That, at a minimum, documented landings terminal dates of both March 25, 2003 and a date in or around 2005 should be included.
- 2. That a Hard TAC should not be considered for the current management action for Small Mesh Multispecies until scientific information is sufficient to estimate Maximum Sustainable Yield (MSY) and/or Optimum Yield (OY) for this fishery.
- 3. For juvenile whiting protections:
  - a. That the Panel believes there is no directed juvenile whiting fishery and recommends that restrictions on size not be considered.
  - b. That options removing net strengtheners from the 2.5 inch-mesh directed small mesh multispecies fishery be considered.
- 4. That options for Dedicated Access Privileges be considered.
