# **Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacon (EPIRB)**



#### Registration of 406 MHz EPIRBs

- Proper registration of your 406 MHz EPIRB or PLB is intended to save your life.
- Your life may be saved as a result of beacon registration information. This
  information can be very helpful in confirming that a distress situation exists,
  and in arranging appropriate rescue efforts.
  - If the EPIRB or PLB is properly registered, the Coast Guard will be able to use the registration information to immediately begin action on the case.
  - If the EPIRB or PLB is unregistered, the Coast Guard may have to delay responding until more information can be attained. Unregistered EPIRBs have needlessly cost the lives of several mariners since the satellite system became operational.
