Enforcement

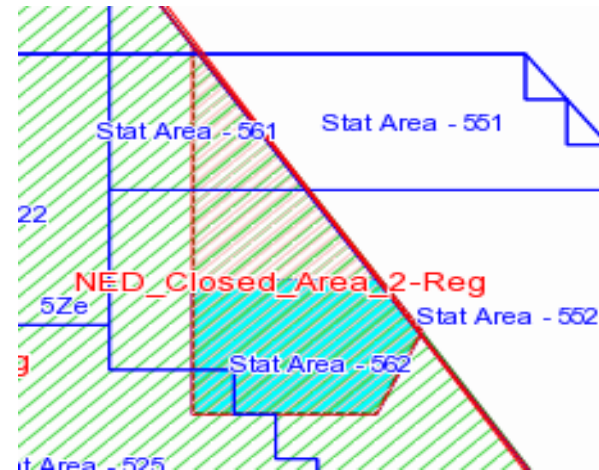
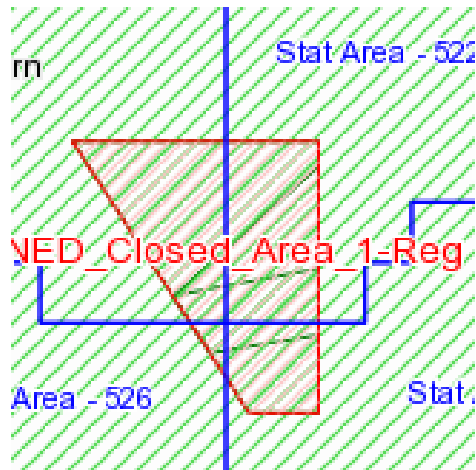
01 March thru 21 April 2014

- **Fishing Vessel Boardings – 188**
- **Fishery Violations Issued – 06**

- **Observed Compliance Rate: 96.8**
- **Last Reported Compliance Rate: 99.1%**

Suspected Closed Area Incursions

- Investigating two cases involving possible Closed Area incursions
- Coast Guard continues to monitor vessels operating near Closed Area boundaries





Safety

01 March thru 21 April 2014



- **Fishing Vessel Boardings – 188**
- **Safety Exams Conducted: 184**
- **CFVS Decals Issued: 143**
- **Safety Violations Issued:**
 - 21 violations to 10 individual vessels
 - 2 terminations due to safety
- **Observed Compliance Rate: 94.6 %**
- **Last Reported Compliance Rate: 89.6 %**



Search and Rescue

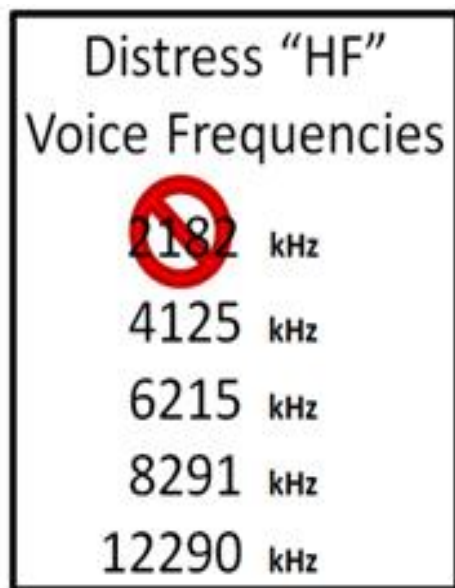
01 March thru 21 April 2014

 - **07 Equipment Casualties**
 - **01 Flooding**
 - **02 Onboard fires**
 - **02 Collision/allision**
 - **03 Sunk/capsized**
- **28 Fishermen assisted**
- **01 Medevacs**
- **00 Fatalities**
