Effective July 3, 2013, NOAA Fisheries reinstated the Eastern U.S./Canada Area quota monitoring methodology where catch is attributed to area fished based on vessel monitoring system (VMS), vessel trip reports (VTRs), and interactive voice recording (IVR) information. This change was retroactively applied to all data since the May 1, 2013, start of the fishing year.

## Notice

**NMFS closed the directed herring fishery in Management Area 2 on April 7, 2013, because over 95 percent of the catch limit for that area has been caught. Effective 0001 hr, April 7, 2013, federally permitted vessels may not fish for, catch, possess, transfer, or land more than 2,000 lb (907.2 kg) of Atlantic herring (herring) per trip or calendar day in or from Management Area 2 until January 1, 2014, when the 2014 allocation for Area 2 becomes available. Also effective 0001 hr, April 7, 2013, federally permitted dealers may not receive more than 2,000 lb (907.2 kg) of herring caught within Management Area 2 per trip or calendar day.**

The Atlantic herring fishery is monitored using data provided by herring-permitted vessels (VMS catch reports and VTRs) and Federal/state dealer data. VMS catch reports will be used to verify and determine catch when VTR and/or dealer records are unavailable, but VTR and dealer reports, once received, will determine final catch by area.

Catch reporting requirements are as follows: Limited access herring vessels report catch daily via VMS, open access herring vessels report catch weekly via the IVR system, and all herring-permitted vessels submit VTRs weekly. Failure to submit reports, including the requirement to submit a negative VTR for any week when no catch was made, has resulted in vessels being referred to the NOAA Office of Law Enforcement for investigation.

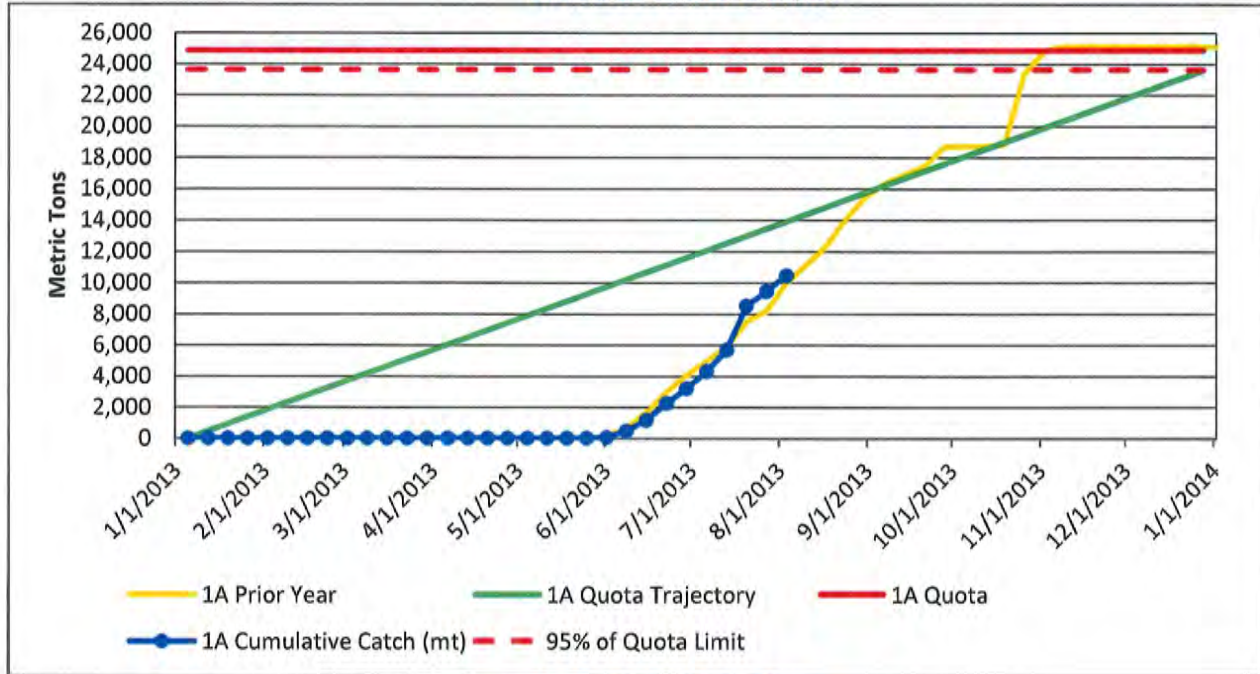

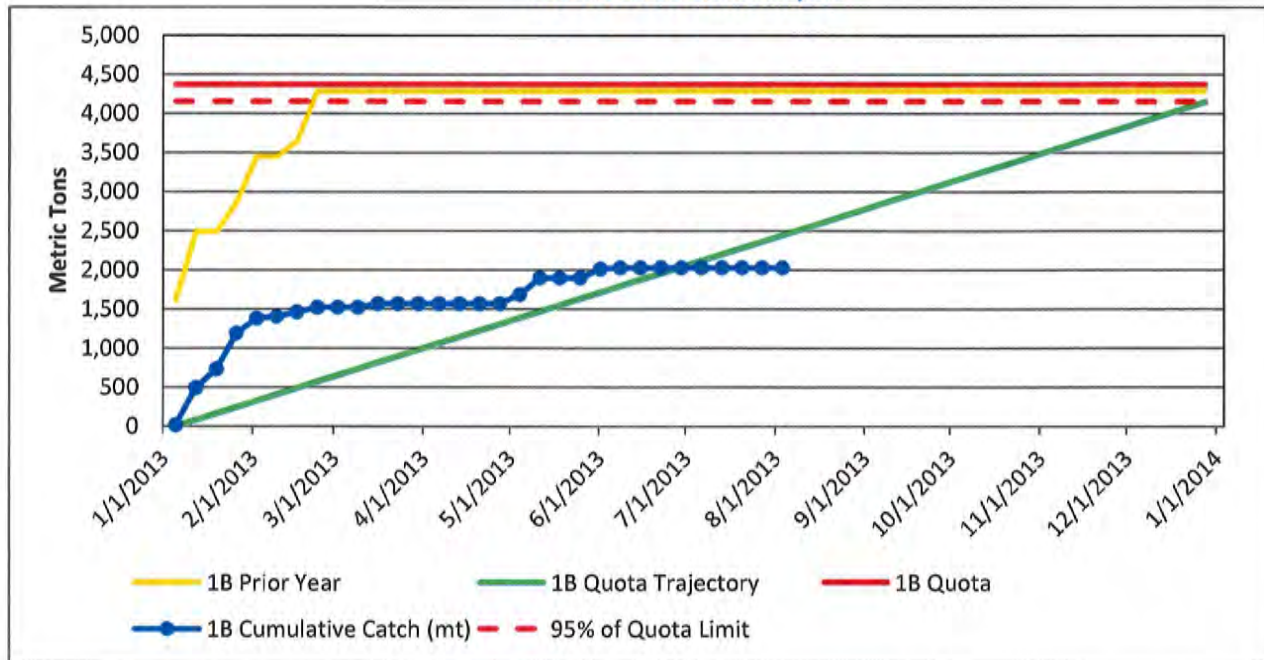

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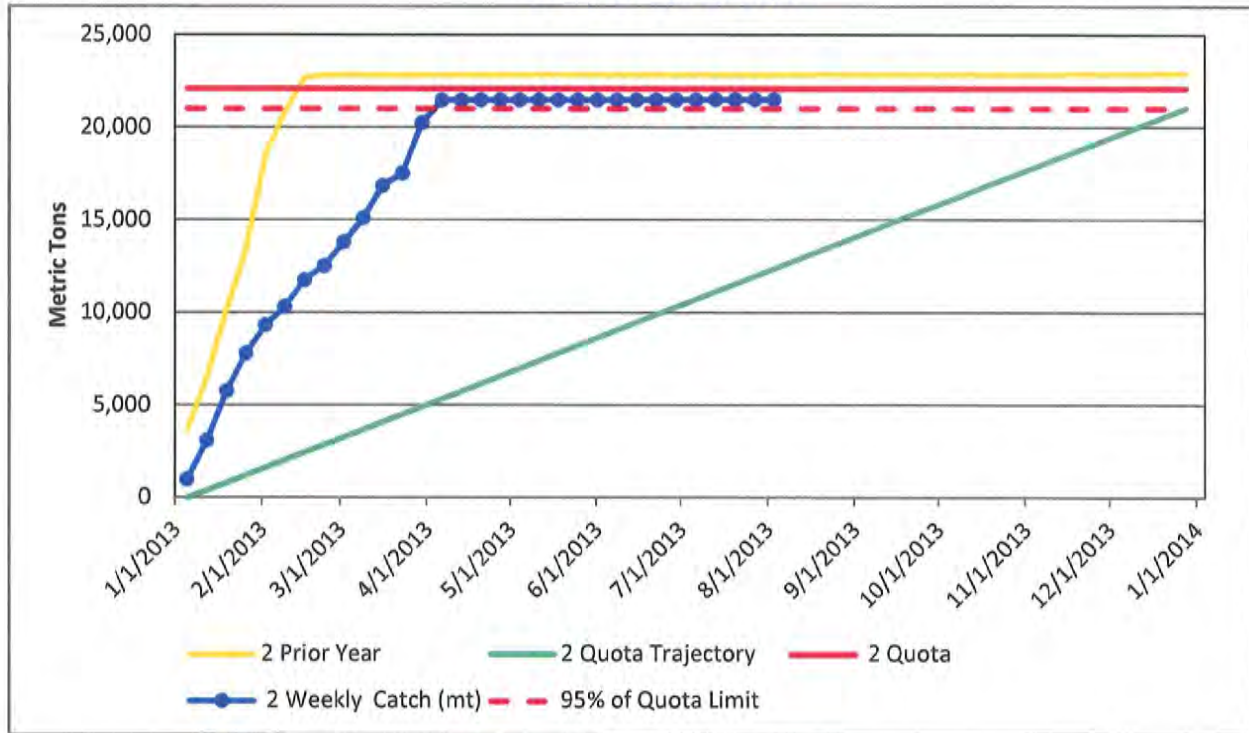
### Atlantic Herring 2013 Area 1A Quota Report

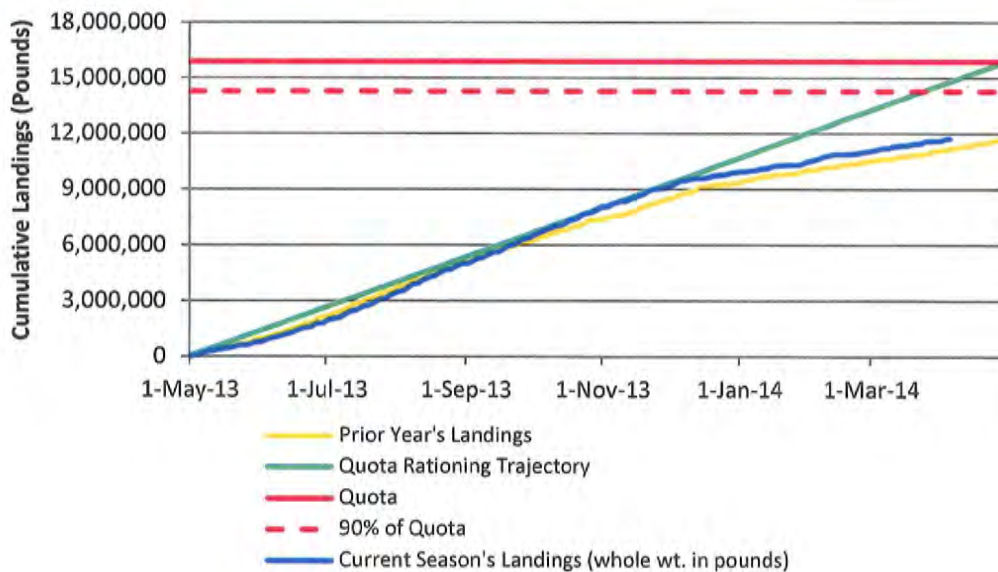

## Regulations

### Notice

Period I (May 1 to October 31) of the spiny dogfish fishery is open with a possession limit of 4,000 lb per trip. Vessels continue to be prohibited from landing more than one trip per calendar day.

Negative landings can be the result of updates to the database (e.g. reported Research Set-Aside landings are subtracted from the Commercial Current Week's Landings or Previous Weeks' Updates). As a result, the Commercial Current Week's Landings or Previous Weeks' Updates can be negative.
