# **Research Steering Committee**

#### I. STATUS

### A. Meetings:

The Council's Research Steering Committee met on May 30-31, 2006 to: 1) conduct a management review of seven final reports submitted to the Northeast Region's Cooperative Research Partners Program and forwarded to the RSC; 2) discuss further refinements to the management review process; and 3) and review the sea scallop research set-aside process.

The objective of an RSC evaluation of final reports is to provide feedback to the Council, its oversight committees and Plan Development Teams on the applicability and use of project results in management decision-making. The meeting summary contains the RSC's comments on the reports. Recommendations on other issues also are discussed in the meeting summary.

A. The Council should review the recommendations of the RSC concerning use of the final project results in a management context and consider other issues contained in the summary and identified by the RSC Chairman as necessary.
