- B. Amendment 11: The Council approved goals and objectives for Amendment 11 at the April 2006 Council meeting, as well as an allocation range to be considered for the general category fishery. The Scallop PDT and advisory panels have met since the last Council meeting to review and develop additional recommendations for consideration. The Scallop Committee has reviewed these recommendations and approved a final range of measures to be considered by the full Council at this meeting.

The Scientific and Statistical Committee has met to review updated biological reference points developed by the Scallop PDT. These estimates will be available for decision makers during development of Amendment 11.
