I. STATUS

A. Meetings

The Scientific and Statistical Committee (SSC) met on May 16 in Mansfield MA. The SSC reviewed the approach used by the Council's Closed Area Technical Team (CATT) to identify important juvenile groundfish habitat and spawning locations. The SSC's recommendations are in the May 28, 2013 memo from the SSC to Thomas Nies (Information item #1).

The SSC also reviewed the 2013 Monkfish Operational Assessment results and the Monkfish PDT's calculations for ABCs based on the default ABC control rule. The SSC decided to request additional information from the PDT and postponed finalizing recommendations to a future meeting.
