

JEAN-JACQUES MAGUIRE

Mr. Maguire worked for the Canadian Department of Fisheries and Oceans (DFO) from 1977 to 1996, in Dartmouth, Nova Scotia, Québec City, Québec, and Mont-Joli, Québec. He has led stock assessment teams in DFO and participated in stock assessment review processes on both coasts of North America, in both Canada and the U.S., for the International Council for the Exploration of the Sea (ICES) and for the International Commission for the Conservation of Atlantic Tunas (ICCAT). In addition to chairing the bluefin tuna working group for ICCAT, Mr. Maguire also chaired both the pelagic and groundfish subcommittees of the former Canadian Atlantic Fisheries Scientific Advisory Committees before chairing its Steering Committee. He was a member of the Advisory Committee on Fisheries Management (ACFM) of ICES during the period 1989-1999.

As a consultant in fisheries science and fisheries management since 1996, Mr. Maguire chaired the ACFM of ICES, and works regularly for the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations, and for national and international, as well as fishing industry and environmental non-governmental organizations. He has been a member of the Canadian Fishery Resource Conservation Council since 2002.
