I. STATUS

MEETINGS AND ONGOING WORK

The <u>Habitat PDT</u> met on December 7 and January 4, and had a conference call on January 12 to further develop alternatives to protect deep-sea corals in the Northeast Region, and to discuss options to minimize the adverse effects of fishing on EFH.

Meeting outcomes:

- Developed advice to Habitat Committee about which areas to recommended as deep-sea coral protection zones on the basis of (1) documented coral presence, and/or (2) inferred presence of suitable habitat
- Discussed metrics to be used for evaluating adverse effect options/areas
- Developed a list of habitat research objectives/questions and generic design for dedicated habitat research areas

The <u>Habitat Advisory Panel</u> and <u>Habitat Committee</u> will meet jointly on January 24 review (1) PDT-recommended deep-sea coral alternatives and (2) options to minimize the effects of fishing on EFH. The Habitat Committee meeting that was scheduled for January 25 will be rescheduled for a later date.

No Council action on Omnibus Amendment alternatives at this meeting. The Habitat Committee chair and Council staff will provide an update on Omnibus Amendment progress.
