**SUBJECT:** Gear exemptions from spawning areas

Definitions of exempted gears in rolling closures and other groundfish areas differ, either because of special circumstances, differences in areas, or other characteristics. Since the Omnibus Habitat Amendment 2 would change the purpose of these areas and seasonal adjustments may be considered, it is worth examining data to determine whether the exempted or prohibited gear definitions warrant modification.

Using 2010-2012 sea sampling and at sea monitoring data, Council staffer Dave Thomas summarized the catches of large mesh groundfish as a percent of total catch by gear type in the months that spawning areas could apply for Omnibus Habitat Amendment 2 alternatives (see table below). Catch observations for some gears is lacking (blank cells) because either the gear is prohibited by current regulations or the gear is sampled at a relatively low level and there are no samples for that gear during the analyzed period.

Nonetheless the highest large mesh groundfish catch rate for exempted gears (colored cells in the table below) is 1.2% and there is nothing that indicates that different gear exemptions would be needed for the new spawning area alternatives.



## All gears exempt from GOM Rolling Closures

Spears, Rakes, Diving Gear, Cast Nets, Tongs
Harpoons, Weirs, Dip Nets, Stop Nets, Pound Nets
Pots and Traps, Purse Seines, Surf Clam/Quahog Dredge Gear
Pelagic Hook and Line, Pelagic Longlines, Single Pelagic Gillnets
Shrimp Trawls (with properly configured grates)

## All gears exempt from Closed Area 1 and 2

Pot Gear for Lobsters and Hagfish, Pelagic Hook and Line Pelagic Longline Gear, Harpoon Gear, Tuna Purse Seine Pelagic Mid-Water Trawl Gear, Tuna Purse Seine Gear
