I. STATUS

- A. Meetings: The Joint Groundfish /Scallop Committee met April 5, 2010. A meeting summary is attached.
- B. <u>GB Yellowtail Flounder Rebuilding Strategy:</u> In November, 20099 the Council voted to consider revising the rebuilding strategy for this stock. The PDT will present a memo identifying possible alternatives. The Council will be asked to identify alternatives that will be considered later this.
- C. <u>Vessel Buyback Regulations</u>: Council staff will provide an overview of M-S Act vessel buyback regulations. This is in response to interest expressed about the possibility of a multispecies buyback program.
- D. <u>Multispecies Management Actions:</u> The Final Rules for Amendment 16, Framework Adjustment 44, and FY 2010 Sector Operations Plans were published April 9, 2010. Implementation is scheduled for May 1, 2010.
- E. Amendment 16/17: In January the Council directed that a Joint Groundfish/Scallop Committee develop a management action to facilitate the transfer of groundfish stocks between the two fisheries. The Committee met in early April to begin that process. The Committee will seek additional guidance from the Council.
