Specifically, the committee developed a recommendation for the 2011-2013 red crab Acceptable Biological Catch (ABC) and reconsidered its 2010 red crab ABC recommendation. Members also reconsidered the 2010-2011 ABC recommendation for the skate complex (incorporating updated survey information), reviewed and discussed work to date on its draft ecosystem-based fishery management plan white paper and recommended Terms of Reference for the fall 2010 SARC.
